
















## Year 3 SPJS Curriculum Headlines

Week beginning: 1<sup>st</sup> July 2024

Below is an outline of what your child will be learning this week. To help you support your child, we have provided relevant website links as well as a brief summary of the learning outcomes.

Subject	What pupils will be learning
<p><b>Writing and Reading</b></p> 	<p>We will continue to read our class novel: Friend or Foe by Michael Morpurgo. Our main character, David, has been evacuated so we are planning and writing a letter home to Mum. We will gather lots of amazing vocabulary, using a thesaurus to help extend our choices. During our DERIC sessions we will explore the poem 'My Shadow' by Robert Louis Stevenson. We will complete some comprehension questions then perform some of his other poems.</p>
