Below is an outline of what your child will be learning this week. To help you support your child, we have provided relevant website links as well as a brief summary of the learning outcomes.

Subject	What pupils will be learning
Reading/Writing	<p>Writing: We will revise how Cinderella of the Nile differs from the traditional story. Then, we will look at the 'twisted' elements and make our own changes. We will work with a story mountain and complete our own blurb to ensure we are totally confident with our plot.</p> <p>Reading: This week we will enjoy one of Roald Dahl's own twisted tales - his revolting rhyme of 'Little Red Riding Hood'.</p>
Spelling/ Vocabulary	<p> Single chilli: random  Double chilli: tranquil Topic: valley</p> <p>If your child would like to use Spelling Shed to support their spelling practice at home, their login details are in their HS Books. We have now set 2 tasks per week to help them revise the spelling rules we have already studied. They can also access the Common Exception Words by selecting More, My Lists and then selecting Stage 1 and 2 for the Y1/2 words and Stage 3 and 4 for the Y3/4 words. All tasks are optional but there if you wish to use them.</p>
