















Year 3 SPJS Curriculum Headlines

Week beginning: 29th April 2024

Below is an outline of what your child will be learning this week. To help you support your child, we have provided relevant website links as well as a brief summary of the learning outcomes.

Subject	What pupils will be learning
Reading/Writing 	<p>Writing: We will focus on character descriptions as we introduce the children to our new text - Cinderella of the Nile by Marjan Vafaeian.</p> <p>Reading: This week we will enjoy a Star Wars Character Poem by Penny Szentkuti.</p>
Spelling/ Vocabulary	<p>We will revise speech punctuation. Our spelling focus is adding -ally to root words ending in -ic e.g. magically. This week's words to boost the children's vocabulary are:</p> <p> Single chilli: dart  Double chilli: idyllic Topic: summit</p> <p>If your child would like to use Spelling Shed to support their spelling practice at home, their login details are in their HS Books. We have now set 2 tasks per week to help them revise the spelling rules we have already studied. They can also access the Common Exception Words by selecting More, My Lists and then selecting Stage 1 and 2 for the Y1/2 words and Stage 3 and 4 for the Y3/4 words. All tasks are optional but there if you wish to use them.</p>
Maths 	<p>We will continue to focus on money. Specifically, we will learn to add amounts, subtract amounts and calculate change.</p> <p>Our next unit is TIME.
